

2022-2023 Registration Information

Registration begins on APRIL 4, 2022

FULL DAY PRE-KINDERGARTEN

The Conroe Independent School District offers full day Pre-Kindergarten.

Your child must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2022, to enroll for Pre-Kindergarten. This program is only available to those who qualify based on:

- Limited English Proficiency
- Homeless
- Parent is Active, Injured, or Deceased Member of the Armed Forces
- Educationally Disadvantaged
- Receiving Medicaid Assistance
- Foster Child Placement through CPS
- Eligible for Star of Texas Award

This is a full day program that begins at 8:00 am and ends at 3:10 pm. For those applying based on Limited English Proficiency, a verbal test will be administered once all registration requirements have been submitted.

KINDERGARTEN

Your child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2022, to enroll for Kindergarten. Per the TEA (Texas Education Agency), we are unable to offer any competency testing if your child does not meet the age requirement.

GRADES 1st – 4TH

Follow the directions to complete registration and be sure to include prior school information and if possible, withdrawal papers or last report card when completing registration. If your 1st grader has not completed KG in a public school they are required to be 6 years of age on or before September 1, 2022.

- 2) Social Security Card (If born in the USA)
- 3) Immunization Record
- 4) Proof of Residency- This can be a utility bill showing your service address or a Lease/Contract
